Each year, our Charitable Giving Campaign provides financial support to organizations making meaningful differences in our communities.

\$5,000 donations were made to the Surrey Food Bank for their Tiny Bundles Program which included formula, diapers and wipes, baby cereal and jar foods, and baby toiletries, and the Surrey Hospitals Foundation where Surrey residents and those south of the Fraser can receive care closer to home at Surrey Memorial Hospital.
